A Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
(5-Sec. 26) North 1/16 corner Section 26. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.
(1-Sec. 26) West 1/16 corner between Sections 23-26. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(5-Sec. 26) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Quarter corner and Center of Section 1306.33' north and south. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1°IDx36' iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(1-Sec. 26) Found the corner position monumented by a 1° square iron pin placed by unknown surveyor. I determined the monument to be 0.62' south of a straight line between Section corner to west and Quarter corner to east, and 0.08' east of the midpoint. I accepted the pin as a careful and faithful determination of the position of the corner. Left the pin in place and marked bearing trees as described below.
