

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(IS) Corner common to Sections 10-11-14-15. Established in 1852 by Zelotes 8. Searles: "S6'E Corrected... 80.00 Set post Cor. of Secs. 10,11,14,15. Y. Birch 4 S34N 15, Fir 8 N10E 7. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(15) Remonumented the corner at the probable original location determined by the recovery of an old post point, preserved below and rotted off at the water table, about 12° below the ground surface. The post was found at record bearing and distance from the root remains of an unidentified hardwood tree \$38M 9.9' and from the root remains of an unidentified coniferous tree MISE 4.6', which I believe are the remains of the original bearing trees. A second, never post point was found adjacent to the old point. It projects about 3" above ground. A cedar with approx 40 yr. old blazes facing the post point is also nearby. At the position of the older post I place a 1° ID x 32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by D.Lampelm and B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
