

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

(F9) Original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. I reestablished this corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between Section corners 39,9725 ch. East and West. At the position for the corner I placed a 1° I.D. x 32° iron pipe capped with a yellow plastic cap stamped "MICH DNR PS 33986". Corner placed and witnessed by D.Lampela and B.Mheeler, Baraga District Office.

(16-Sec. 28) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between quarter corner 19.9233 ch. west and Section corner 19.9233 ch. east.
