

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- (H10) Center of Section 27. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.
- (IIO) Quarter corner common to Sections 26-27. Corner established in 1852 by Zelotes B. Searles: "M3'E Corrected...40.12 Set quarter Section post. Sugar B M70E 15, Fir 4 M47M 17." Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(H10) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite quarter corners. At the position for the corner I placed a 1°10x32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by D.Lampela and B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office.
(I10) Original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between Section corners 40.0646 ch. north and south. I observed the true bearing of the line to be N 8° 11° E. I found an old squared post, down on the ground, apparently an approximate commer postion, roughly S80E 42 ft. from the corner position. At the position for the corner I placed a 1°10x32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by D.Lampela and B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office.
