B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(A7) Recovered the 1969 monument as described, in good condition, but leaning heavily in very unstable soil. The 1969 bearing trees were recovered in good condition. I plumbed the monument so as to put it in conformance with Lappala's two Cedar bearing trees. From this position, I measure 16.5' to the Black Spruce, not the 17.0' stated in the record. I accept the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner and remeasure the 1969 witness tree and mark one new tree as described below. Corner recovered and rewitnessed by D.Lampela and B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office.
