- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;
- (F5) Remonumented the corner at the point remains of an old wood post and the probable remains of the 2 spruce bearing trees. The post point was found, rotted off at the water table, at record bearing and distance from both a rotting spruce stump, 20° in dia. With remains of a blaze and axe marks visible, M328 8.3', and the root remains of a long-ago rotted spruce, S85M 3.3'. The distance west to a remonumented corner is 39.523 ch. which is at odds with the record, but the measured distance 121.0421 ch. east checks well with the original 120.925 chains. A reestablished corner is 40.164 ch. east. At the position of the post-point, I placed a 1° ID x 32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner was placed and witnessed by D.tampela and 8.Mheel@r,-Baraga District Office. Corner is in a large alder swamp.
