

## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(£4) Quarter corner common to Sections 8-9. Established in 1852 by Zelotes 8. Searles: "40.00 Set quarter Section post. Heml 14 S47M 27. Fir 12 M40E 10". Found no subsequent record.

(H6) Center of Section 15. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(£4) Original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no evidence of prior monumentation. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Corner location is in a clearcut area. In the vicinity, there is a 14° M. Birch with a location poster (unidentified) and a single blaze, and an American Co. location poster on an 8° Maple. Posters indicate corner location to be SM approx 50° from the position monumented. I reestablish the corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between Section corners 40.148 ch. north and south, being proportionate to the original record. At the position for the corner, I place a 1° ID x 36° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by B. Mheeler and D. Lämpela, Baraga District Office.

(H6) Found no evidence of prior manumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite quarter corners. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1° ID x 32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by D.Lampela and B.Mheeler, Baraga District Office.
