Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner. Found 3/4" (i.d.) x 16" long iron pipe with illegible LS cap. Fire clay found below 3/4" pipe, 2.7' below pavement surface. Existing Maxson witnesses prove this pipe to be same as he recorded. Accepted Fire clay as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. Set a standard Jackson County Survey Monument (JCSM) in exact position of found Fire clay. Buried Fire clay on South side of JCSM. Also found a second 3/4" (i.d.) x 24" long iron pipe with illegible LS cap, 0.47" South of first pipe and Fire clay. Based upon Kellers' witnesses, I believe this is the pipe he recorded. However, since his witnesses do not work well together and the cap being illegible, I cannot be certain. The indication is that his corner would have been South of Maxson's. This second 3/4" x 24" pipe is rejected and not utilized in this survey.
