Erickson, in a field survey on December 21, 19 95, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5. above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

In 1825, J. Wampler - Deputy Surveyor, set a "Post" and recorded 2 witnesses: "B. Oak 9, S80°E, 35 (23.10')" and "W. Oak 7, N22 1/2°W, 8 (5.28')".

In 1888, H.F. Bean reported "Found stone with earthen ware around it, set F.C. Post in place of stone." and recorded 2 witnesses: "Hickory 12, N26 1/4°W, 558 (368.28')" and "Hickory 20, N83 1/2°E, 344 1/2 (227.37')".

Records from the Jackson County Road Commission (JCRC) are not dated, do not give a monument description, but do list 2 witnesses as "Wood Fe. Post, West, 5.45" and "Steel Fe. Post, East, 12.12', S.H.D."

State Highway plans (File No. 38-R-2, Sheet #110) for M-106 show the corner and give ties to the road, but give no description.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 3" x 24" Fire Clay, upside down between several large stones, 1' below surface. Also found several pieces of brick and crockery near base of Fire Clay. Remains (wire in ground) of old East-West fence found over Fire Clay. Also found 31" long axle with 3 1/2" dia. gear on top, 1' below surface. Axle surrounded by several 4"-6" field stones. No crockery or brick around axle. Axle fits JCRC witness 12.12' East. Also found 3/4" rebar at surface. No crockery or brick around rebar. Accepted Fire Clay as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. Set a standard Jackson County Survey Monument (JCSM) in exact position of found Fire Clay. Buried brick & crockery on North side of JCSM. Set 4 R.R. spikes around base of JCSM.

Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;

Set 4" dia. x 36" long concrete monument with 1/2" dia. x 36" long rebar and Jackson County standard aluminum cap stamped "E-10, LS #29245, 1995".
