In 1988, D.A. Ankrom - LS # 21265, recorded the corner as "Fire clay post with 1/2" rerod and cap #21265 on West side" per LCRC at Liber 4, Page 128.

Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found Fire clay with capped iron "DAA 21265" on South side of Fire clay. Accepted Fire clay as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Set a standard Jackson County Survey Monument (JCSM) at the exact position of found Fire clay. Buried Fire clay on North side of monument.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 4" dia. x 36" long concrete. monument with 1/2" dia. x 36" long rebar and Jackson County Standard Aluminum Cap stamped "LS #29245, 1995, G-12, T1S, R1E".
