In 1825, J. Wampler - Deputy Surveyor, reported "1/2 mile corner in marsh, no post set" at 7.00 chains North, Wampler notes "Grand River 2.00 S.W.".

In 1888, H.F. Bean reported "Established this corner 97 links South of River. Set F.C. post and stake, " and "No witness trees

Field notes dated 9-24-29, in Book H-2, on file at Gutekunst Surveyors Office, on pages 10-13, 26 & 27 indicate the corner as "as in line between sec cors" with distances North and South as 2544.70 feet.

In 1988, D.A. Ankrom - LS #21265 recorded the corner as "2 1/2" pipe filled with concrete 22'+ North of Portage River bank in Tag Alder area", per Land Corner Recordation Certificate (LCRC) at Liber 4, Page 93.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Found 3" iron pipe, 4' high, filled with concrete, leaning South, 22'+ North of the North bank of the Portage River Drain. Area is extremely wet, brushy and inaccessible. Access only possible on top of ice. Did not dig for Fire clay (F.C.) due to water and frozen ground. Pipe is consistent with monument found and accepted at I-10. Accepted found 3" iron pipe as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the corner as established by Bean. (A discrepancy exists between Bean and Wampler. Bean says he was 97 links South, and Wampler implies he was 7.00 chains South of the river. Significant distortion in the town line would support this discrepancy). Set a 60" long aluminum pipe with cap against South edge of leaning pipe. Cap is very nearly directly below top of iron pipe. Set a steel fence post at South edge of cap, flush. Corner position is approximately 1 chain South of Old Portage River channel. Corner is just North of the Portage River Drain, as constructed by the Army Corps of Engineers in the early 1900's.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 60" long aluminum pipe and cap stamped "LS #29245, I-12, T1S-R1E, 1996".
