1, <u>David E. Erickson</u>, in a field survey on <u>February 2</u>, 19 <u>96</u>, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, <u>Michigan P.A. of 1970</u>, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded NOTE: on this certificate.

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

In 1825, J. Wampler - Deputy Surveyor, set a "Post" and recorded: "No bearing trees. All marsh."

In 1888, H.F. Bean reported "Established this corner on line with the Section corners East and West. Each mile is 80 57 1/2. Set post in marsh." and recorded "No witnesses. This post is 2 14/100 chains South of river."

Field notes dated 9-24-29, in Book H-2, on file at Gutekunst Surveyors Office, on pages 10-13, give distances to corner I-12 as North 2544.70 feet, J-13 as East 2659.78 feet and I-1 (T2S-R1E) as West 57.42 feet. Pages 54 and 55 of the same book, dated 1/65 give various references.

in 1988, D.A. Ankrom - LS #21265 recorded the corner as "found 1" pipe from 1929 survey badly bent in march, set rerod and cap #25826 (Bruce Antcliff)" per Land Corner Recordation Certificate (LCRC) at Liber 4, Page 93.

A Certificate of Survey (C.O.S.) by T. Van Gieson - RLS #24621, dated 11-8-90, notes the corner as "Fire clay".

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found Fire clay (F.C.) down 0.5' in marsh. A 1" iron pipe, leaning Northeasterly is on North side of F.C. A 1/2" x 18" rebar with cap "BA 25826" is on South side of F.C. Accepted F.C. as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner as reestablished by Bean in 1888. Set a 60" long aluminum pipe with cap at exact location of F.C. Buried F.C. on South side and capped iron on West side of monument. Left 1" pipe as found. Corner is 30'+ Southeasterly of a narrow, shallow drain running Easterly and Southwesterly.

Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the comer:

Set 60" long aluminum pipe and cap stamped "LS #29245, I-13, T1S-R1E, 1996".
