FOUND FIRECLAY LEANING (NEARLY LYING DOWN) NW'LY.

I DUG 1' BELOW GROUND AT THE BASE OF THE FIRECLAY AND FOUND A FENCE POST WITH
STONES AROUND IT. THE FIRECLAY SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN REMOVED (WHEN THE FENCE POST
WAS PUT IN) AND RESET ON THE NORTH SIDE OF FENCE POST. THE FIRECLAY AND FENCE
POST WERE ACCEPTED AS A PERPETUATION OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER AS
