Accepted Stone as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner as remonumented by Gifford in 1889.

It was decided by Ronnie Lester, IS # 18998, Eaton County Representative; Donald Davis, IS #17617, Calhoun County Representative and Dean R. Gutekunst, RLS # 18658, Jackson County Surveyor & Representative, that Calhoun County would set a Harrison monument for this corner. The Harrison monument was set November 10, 1995, using the following witnesses, in place of the capped iron set 7/17/95 and over the position of the buried stone, and 6" below the gravel surface.
