Erickson</u>, in a field survey on <u>June 28</u>, 19 <u>95</u>, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

In 1825, H. Parke - Deputy surveyor, set a "post" and did not record any witnesses. The "falling" noted is 0.87 (57.42') West of corner 1-13.

Between 1886 and 1888, H.F. Bean reported "post gone. Established it. Set post in marsh." and did not record any

In 1988, D.A. Ankrom - LS #21265, recorded the corner as "Found Fire clay buried 1'± in swampy area at government jog ± from I-13 T1S-R1E, remains of wood post. Set rerod & cap #21265 on South side" per Land Corner Recordation Certificate (LCRC) in Liber 4, Page 94.

A Certificate of Survey (C.O.S.) by T. Van Gieson - RLS #24261, dated 11-8-90, notes the corner as "Fire clay".

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

Found Fire clay (F.C.) down 0.8' in muck. A capped iron #21265 is on the South side. F.C. is determined to be 0.75' North of the township line between standard corners I-13 and H-13. Accepted F.C. as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner as re-established by Bean. Determined <u>"Amended"</u> corner position on the standard line, by using the F.C. to determine Section line only. Set a 60" aluminum pipe and cap at this "Amended" corner position. Corner falls near West edge of a narrow, shallow drain running Easterly and Southwesterly.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 60" long aluminum pipe with cap stamped "LS #29245, 1996, I-1, T2S-R1E".
