I, <u>David E. Erickson</u>, in a field survey on <u>March 1</u> 19 <u>96</u>, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

In 1825, H. Parke - Deputy Surveyor set a "Post" and recorded two witnesses: "Tamarack 10, S78°E, 24" (15.84') and Tamarack 12, S82°W, 14" (9.24').

Around 1888, H.F. Bean reported "Post and One Witness standing" and recorded two witnesses: "B. Oak 20, N1°E, 562" (370.92') and "B. Oak 12, S89 1/2°W, 332 1/2" (219.45').

This corner has not been recorded under PA 74 of 1970.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Searched area determined by extending fence line from West, and doubling distance over from occupation fence a quarter mile west. Less than 1 foot from this position, find a 7" x 30" long pointed wooden post with very distinct "hack" marks, 0.5' below surface of Marsh. Post was in between a layer of tangled trees and logs about 2' below surface. Could not find a Fire Clay or anything else at this location. From this post I measure Northerly 371' to the center of a 4' Oak stump at the West edge of a trall road. I also measure Westerly, 225' to an "estimated" center of a 32" uprooted Oak, 4' South of the fence. This tree fell Easterly, and the exact distance is very hard to determine. Also searched area at midpoint between section corners. Nothing found here. I accept the found wood post as the best available evidence of a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. I believe this could be the original post. It fits Beans trees, is in a low, very wet marshy area, and fits the occupation West (no occupation East of North) extremely well. Set a 60' aluminum pipe with cap at the exact location of the found pointed wood post. Set post on East side of pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a 60" long aluminum pipe with Jackson County Standard Aluminum Cap stamped "LS #29245, L-13, 1996".
