Post at aver. dist." and recorded two witnesses "Tamarack 14, S17°W, 256" (168.96') and "do 8, N40°W, 190" (125.40"). in the late 1800's, a Remonumentation Surveyor reported "Corner gone. At average distance (39.97 ch) found remains of 2nd Gov't Witness agreeing" and recorded two witnesses: "Tam 8, N30°W, 20 2/3" (13.64') and "Tam 8, S39°W, 27 1/2" (18.15'). In 1977, R.E. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Found bottom 1.35' of Fire Clay (FC) flush with ground. Also found 3 pieces of pottery on South side and a 1 3/4" iron pipe up 1.5' on West side of FC. Found concrete monument set by Gutekunst 30.18' East. (It appears an error was made when attempting to set this monument at the midpoint).
