L-9: Found Fisher's accessory trees. White Oak now 34" and Maple now 16"± stump. Also found sandstone with brick pieces 24.75'± North. Dug 2.2' (East-West) x 2.0' (North-South) hole in asphalt based on Fisher's accessory distances. Found intact fire clay at a depth of 2.4'. Also found brick memorials starting at a depth of 4' and ending at 5'. Fire clay is 6.98' South and 0.89' West of corner recorded in Liber 2 Page 632.
