  Although the witness distance of 127.71' would probably fit both the rod set in 1917 and the stone found in 1883 and 1995, the rod appears to have been set with a 3° error in the bearing, and the
- Accepted STONE as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner, as remonumented by Cook and Blair in 1883. Set a Standard Jackson County Monument and left the stone and bar buried beside the monument.
