

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found fireclay, at surface gravel, Arnold Road , near south edge from 1968 witnesses. Broken brick was around and under fireclay.

Accepted fireclay as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner as remonumented by LaRue, in 1884. Replaced fireclay with a Standard Jackson County Monument and left fireclay on north side of monument and with brick under and around Monument is 4" below gravel surface of Arnold Road.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 4" diameter x 36" concrete monument with a ½" x 36" steel H-5 **T4S, R2E** rod and an aluminum cap stamped LS 18658, which is the standard monument for Jackson County
