Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

13 In 1825, R. Clark Jr. - Deputy Surveyor, set a "Post" and recorded two witnesses: "W. Oak 5, S40 1/2°W, 68" (44.88') and "B.

In 1886, H.F. Bean reported "Found Stone corner & 2 Witnesses. Set fire clay post 2 Rods North" and recorded two witnesses: "W. Oak 24, N73°W, 144" (95.04') and "Hickory 10, S71°E, 134 1/2" (88.77').

Consumers Power Company records dated 1958, indicate the corner as "Found 1/2" iron rod at intersection of Snow and Consumers Power Company recurds dated 1906, indicate the corner as Fround (12 from rob at intersection of Show ar Fowler Roads." and recorded three witnesses: "8" Hickory SW 57.91'; "8" Hickory NE 55.31'; Square Conc. Post SE 38.65".

A Jackson County Road Commission (JCRC) comer index card indicates: "Section cor. common to Sec. 9, 10, 15 & 16, T4S, A Jackson County Road Commission (CCRC) come: mack care misicales. Section cor. Congine to Sec. 3, 10, 13 & 19 R2W, Hanover Twp." and lists three witnesses: "8" Hickory SW 57.91'; 8" Hickory NE 55.31'; Sq. Conc. Post SE 38.65".

A corner witness card dated 12/22/70 and on file at Gutekunst Surveyors, indicates: "Found iron at Sec. Corner & Found iron 33.0', North & also found bottom 1/2 of F.C. lying on ground. Set F.C. on North side of iron at 33' North of Sec. Corner. Snow 33.0°, North & also round bottom 112 of F.C. typing on ground. Set F.C. on North side of Iron at 33° North of Sec. Corner. Show Road & Fowler Road. Gravel roads." and noted four witnesses: "SE'ly concrete corner post 38.67"; S35°W, 12" Hickory, 58.15'; N75°W, 6" Oak, 83.8'; N'ly, 18" Walnut, 76.45' ".

Not recorded under Public Act 74.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found bottom 8" of Fire Clay (FC) North of road. Excavated 2' deep and found nothing more. Also found a 1" iron pipe (IP) round pottom of or rise city (ro) North of road. Excavated 2 deep and lound nothing more. Also round a 1 doing further with a 1/2" rod inside, 33.0" South of FC. Excavated a 4" diameter hole, 4" deep around found IP. Did not find any further with a 1/2" rod matue, 33.0 South of Fo. Excavated a 4 chamber note, 4 deep around round in. Did not find any further evidence. Accepted found IP as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. Replaced IP with a standard Harrison cast iron monument, down 0.5'.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

Set standard Harrison cast iron monument with cap stamped "#29245".
