In 1986, Jerry Wilcox, RLS #14102, recorded the corner as "Set iron and cap on township line between found East 1/4 corner of Section 12 and found East 1/4 corner of Section 1, using a prorated distance between the Northwest corner of Section 7, T4S, R2W and the East 1/4 corner of Section 1, T4S, R3W. Corner falls in the centerline of a North-South gravel road and in line with a fence to the West," and recorded 4 witnesses: N57°W, 12" Hickory, 31.35'; S71°W, 14" Red Oak, 28.80'; N75°E, 16" White Oak, 42.67'; S38°E, 14" Cherry, 38.25'. This is per a Land Corner Recordation Certificate (LCRC) recorded at Liber 4, Page 51.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Found ½" x 18" smooth iron (without cap). Road is cut on West side and fill on East side. Excavated an area 16' N-S and 6' E-W by 4' deep, centered on iron. Found a 7"  $\times$  8"  $\times$  18" long stone, standing upright, and 0.4' below surface. This stone is 1' North and 0.3' East of found iron. Stone is about 4' South of fence and tree row West. Accepted found stone as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. Replaced stone with a standard Jackson County Harrison Cast Iron Monument. Buried stone in hole. Iron not reset.
