Fargo in the late 1800's, note "Iron corner" and record two witnesses: "Hick 10 S72°W 103 1/2" (68.31') and "B. Oak 22 S11°W 122" (80.52'). These

notes are on file at Gutekunst Surveyors in Books P1-11, and FN5-165, and "I".

Gutekunst Surveyors note the corner as "Found 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" square iron and brick around. 1.8' below surface of gravel road. This corner not recorded under Act #74.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found %" x 19" galvanized pinch pipe at surface. Excavated area with backhoe, centered on iron. Found a 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" x 20" long iron, surrounded by brick, glass, and several large stones, 3.5' below surface. Iron is below pinch pipe. Accepted found iron as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. Replaced Iron with a standard Jackson County Harrison Cast Iron Monument. Buried pipe and iron on North of monument.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Set standard Jackson County Harrison Cast Iron Monument stamped "M-5, #29245".
