B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:		
M9-A9 – Standard Corner common to Section 24 & 25, T26N, R6W and Sections 19 & 30, T26N, R5W – Fd. ½" x 18" rebar with broken cap per Fluharty & Consumers. This iron was set by C. E. Ostling probably in 1972 for survey done in Sec. 24. Apparently set by single proportion to GLO between corners 'M11-A11' and 'M7-A7'. We measure grid bearings and distance of S0°33'42"W 5255.75' (5280' – GLO) to 'M11-A11' and N0°33'32'E 5254.55' (5280' – GLO) to 'M7-A7'. This ½" CIR fits remains of witness #9 and dead snag of #8. All other witnesses are gone. ½" capped rebar accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
