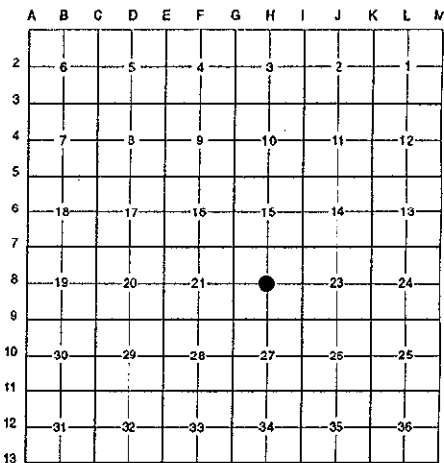

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

H-8 Found a "T" iron 2.5' West of the C/L of Alaska Avenue (bit.) running North and South on line of a brush row and fence line running East per L.C.R.C. #3844, Williams & Works' notes (1956) and the K.C. Surveyor's records. "T" iron is 0.3' East of the intersection of 1/4 lines. Accepted iron as the Center of Section.

L.C.R.C. #3844

- Spike in SW sde 18" Walnut NW 91.20' (m. 91.19')
- Spike in S sde P. Pole fence post N 80° E 35.71'
- PK in SW sde P. Pole S 35° W 76.09' (m. 76.06')
- C/L blacktop 2.5' East
- 1/2" iron 3.5' North and 7' East

The selected location is accepted by me and is generally accepted by professional surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
