- Found a Standard Kent County Monument 3.5' West of the C/L of Alden Nash (bit.) running North and South and 5' North of the C/L of 2 Mile Road (gravel) running West per L.C.R.C.'s #1940 and #5788 as set by Rob Jonker in place of a RR spike he found at grade over a concrete monument 3'8" below grade which checked L.C.R.C. #400 and the K.C. Surveyor's records.
