- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- Found a Standard Kent County Monument in a monument box on the C/L of Lincoln Lake Road (bit.) running North and South, on line of a tree row running East and West, per L.C.R.C.'s #1951 and #8232 as set by Rob Jonker in place of a 3/4" rd, iron he found in a monument box which checked L.C.R.C. #893 and the K.C. Surveyor's records.
