- Found a "T" iron as set by Williams & Works at the intersection of 1/4 lines in 1966 27.0' ± North of a downed fence line running East and West and 1.5' ± East of a downed fence line running North and South per L.C.R.C.'s #893 and #5096, Cert Survey L. 207 P. 1, and the K.C. Surveyor's records. "T" iron is 0.8' South and 0.1' West of the intersection of 1/4 lines. Accepted iron as Center of Section.
