This corner was originally approved by the Kent County Remonumentation Peer Group and monumented by T. Chettleburgh on 2/20/84 and was recorded per L.C.R.C. #3812.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a Standard Kent County Monument 250' ± North of the C/L of Mc Pherson Street (bit.) running East and West, 80' ± K-7 South of the left bank of the Flat River, and 65' \pm East of the left bank of the Flat River per L.C.R.C.'s #3812 and #8257 as set by T. Chettleburgh in place of a 1-1/4" iron pipe he found with a steel fence post guard.
