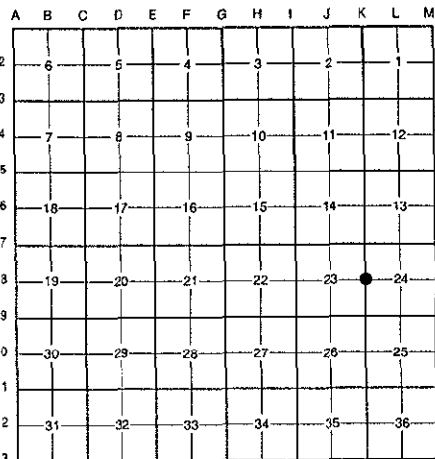

This corner was originally approved by the Kent County Remonumentation Peer Group and monumented by T. Chettleburgh on 2/7/84 and was recorded per L.C.R.C. #3813.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

K-8 Found a Standard Kent County Monument at the intersection of fence lines running North, South, East and West per L.C.R.C.'s #3813 and #8258 as set by T. Chettleburgh in place of an iron pipe he found which checked a 1953 survey by Williams & Works and the K.C. Surveyor's records.
