Found a Standard Kent County Monument at the C/L intersection of Egypt Valley Avenue (bit.) running North and South and 3 Mile Road (gravel) running East and West per L.C.R.C.'s #2578 and #5127 as set by Rob Jonker in place of a 1/2" iron he found at grade in a monument box over a spike 14" below grade and over a 1" iron 18" below grade which checked L.C.R.C.'s #551, #61 and the K.C.
