This corner was originally approved by the Kent County Remonumentation Peer Group and monumented by Randy Kolehouse on 2/20/78 and was recorded per L.C.R.C. #4296.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a Standard Kent County Monument 2' East of a fence line running North and South and 4' ± North of a fence line running East and West per L.C.R.C.'s #4296 and #7976 as set by Randy Kolehouse in place of a ring of 6" stones 3' m/l in dia. and 3' m/l deep with the remains of a very old 1' dia. wood post in the center which checked the 1898 survey of Williams & Works.
