В. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a Standard Kent County Monument 125' ± South of Cannonsburg Road (bit.) running East and West and 22' ± West of the C/L of a bituminous drive running South per L.C.R.C.'s #2365 and #6289 as set by Rob Jonker in place of a 1" iron he found in a stone pile on East edge of swamp which checked L.C.R.C. #1340 and the K.C. Surveyor's records.
