Found a Standard Kent County Monument 5' South of the C/L intersection of Egypt Valley Avenue (bit.) running South and Belding Road (bit.) running East and West on line of a tree row running North per L.C.R.C.'s #2369 and #6294 as set by Rob Jonker in place of a capped iron he found in a monument box over a 1" iron 14" below grade which checked L.C.R.C.'s #3563, #395, #69 and the K.C. Surveyor's records.
