Found a Standard Kent County Monument in a monument box .5' North of the C/L of 15 Mile Road (bit.) running East and West, on line of a fence line running South, per L.C.R.C. #8712 as set by Kirk Breitels in place of a 1" x 10" iron pipe he found in a monument box over a boat spike inside a 1-1/2" iron pipe in a ring of stones which checked L.C.R.C. #3894 and the 1900-1962 notes of Williams & Works.
