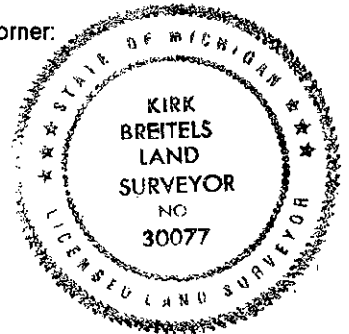
J-10 Found 1/2" Solid Rod per the following remaining witnesses:
Nail in 26" Oak S40°W 34.37' Nail in P. Pole N35°W 39.98' Nail in P. Pole S30°E 136.80'

Said 1/2" Solid Rod is 4.2' E. & less than 0.1' S. from intersection of 1/4 lines and has also been used in surveys by Exxel, Hackbardt and Fricke.

The 1/2" Solid Rod is accepted by me and is generally accepted by professional surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the corner.
