

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

E1: Corner between Sections 4 & 5: Having found the recorded Northwest and Northeast Corners of the Township, all the GLO corners between were set on a true parallel of latitude established by using the secant Method. Position fits well with found evidence.

F1: N1/4 Corner Section 4: Having found the recorded Northwest and Northeast Corners of the Township, all the GLO corners between were set on a true parallel of latitude established by using the secant method. Quarter corners were established satisfying the proportional area measurements as shown on the original Township Plat. Positions fit well with found evidence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

E1: Set 4" Brass Cap stamped for corner on 1" pipe, 13" A.G., 8' No. of Power line Witnesses: 16" Oak N03°E 24.31' 17" H. Maple S34°E 43.92' 10" H. Maple S20°W 49.67' Util. Pole S85°W 49.67'
