

G1: Corner between Sections 3 & 4: Having found the recorded Northwest and Northeast Corners of the Township, all the GLO corners between were set on a true parallel of latitude established by using the secant Method. Position fits well with found evidence.

H1: N1/4 Corner Section 3: Having found the recorded Northwest and Northeast Corners of the Township, all the GLO corners between were set on a true parallel of latitude established by using the secant method. Quarter corners were established satisfying the proportional area measurements as shown on the original Township Plat. Positions fit well with found evidence.
