A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

See previously recorded land corner recordation certificate Liber 1, Page 1488. This corner was ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on April 18, 1996.

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

Found a clay tile with a remonumentation sleeve over it in a monument box. The monument box was removed during milling operations for the reconstruction of 29th Street. However the monument and sleeve were left in place.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

E-11, Southeast Corner Section 29, Town 1 South, Range 10 West. Ratified by Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on April 18, 1996. The position of the found clay tile was accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Set a 20" Harrison Monument in a Monument Box directly over the clay tile.
