



- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- 1827 South quarter corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor John Mullet Accessories: 8" W. Oak North 60 degrees West 28 Links 12" W. Oak South 82 degrees East 39 Links
- 1870 F. Hodgman: Found sec. cor. stake by digging. Planted stake and stone. 10" Hickory North 60 degrees East 77 10" Cherry South 27 degrees East 52 1/2
- Date? KCRC witness notes: 18" Elm South 27.0' 10" W. Cherry South 65 degrees West 64.0' N. road fence North 31.0' Stone 3' below iron above
- 1959 Gove Associates: Pinched Pipe.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original monument and accessories not recovered.

Found 3/4" pinched iron 4" below road surface. Dug further and found a 1" dia. 1.5' long iron pipe directly below pinched iron. Dug further and found a 10" dia. stone with chiseled "X" on top. Stone was 0.11" South and 0.03' East of found iron and pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

D5, South Quarter Post Section 8, Town1 South, Range 11 West, ratified by Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on June 20, 1996. The 12" stone with "X" believed to be same as set by F.Hodgman and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of GARY C the original corner. Removed iron and pipe and set a 20" Harrison Monument in a mon. box over the stone. Set P.K. nail in 12" Elm North 12 degrees East 29.06'

Set P.K. nail in 8" Elm North 63 degrees West 48.08"

Set P.K. nail in 8" Elm South 2 degrees West 21.67"
