

Ran North/South and East/West 1/4 line and found iron in monument box to be 0.10\* North and 0.18' West of true intersection.

Found & iron in monument box as placed on intersection of 1/4 lines by John Kester, RLS #16046 in a 1972 survey. Placed 30" Harrison monument in monument box in place of iron. J-12:
