1873 - F. Hodgman: Found stake hole. Set iron with lime around. South rail of MCRR north 48 lks. (31.68 feet). Hodgman also gives distance of 40.13 chains (2,648.58 feet) to southwest corner section 15 and distance of 40.12 chains (2,647.92 feet) to southeast corner section 15. MDOT highway right of way map indicated corner should be 23.85 feet north of centerline of former 20 foot surface. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

H-7, South quarter post section 15, Town 2 South, Range 10 West, ratified by Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on February 27, 1997.
