

Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original monument and accessories not recovered. Found 3/4" rod (14" long). Removed rod to find disturbed 12" section of tile. Removed tile and dug to a depth of 2.2 feet and found a second section of tile standing vertically. Tile was 0.09 feet north 0.41 feet east of 3/4" rod.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;
 - I-3, Southwest corner section 2, Town 2 South, Range 10 West, ratified by Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on November 20, 1997. Position of tile is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Set a 20" Harrison Monument in a Mon. box over the tile.
