- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- 1827: United States Government Surveyors; set 1/4 post.  
Beech 12" S. 07° E. 13 lks.  
Beech 7" N. 07° W. 22 lks.
  - 1864: F. Stimson, County Surveyor; Sassafras stake from which a Beech 12" S. 88° E. 56 lks.  
Beech 10" S. 59½° W.
  - 1885: F. Hodgman, County Surveyor; found old stake at intersection of fences, N. 88½° W. 56 lks. from stump of witnesses by Stimson in 1862. Bored 3' in white sand, filled the bottom with black earth and put 2' earthen post over: Beech 14" S. 28° E. 62½ lks, Swamp Oak 14" N. 64° E. 148½ lks.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- 1907: Glen Wheaton, Surveyor; found tile at South 1/4 post, Section 24 in a survey of Statler's Acres (unrecorded).
  - 1955: Wilkins & Wheaton Engr. Co.; found tile.  
24" Maple N. 05° E. 12.75' 12" Hickory N. 60° E. 35.15'  
Db1. Elm (8"&12") S. 05° W. 23.2' 12" Elm S. 03° E. 23.3'
  - 1996: Found 3" round tile down about 1½' with top distressed.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:  
L-09" South 1/4 post, Section 24, T. 2 S., R. 11 W., ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on November 11, 1996 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Found 3" round tile as placed by F. Hodgman in 1885 remonumentation survey. Placed remonumentation sleeve over tile.

- 16d Nail in East Side 12" W. Cherry N. 25° E. 6.63'
- 16d Nail in East Side 15" W. Cherry N. 60° E. 10.62'
- Southwest corner of Diversion Dam Fence (3" Steel Post) S. 45° E. 93.92'
- South End of 5' Chain Link Fence center line 3" steel post S. 50° E. 2.04'
