

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

South 1/4 Post Section 34, T. 2 S., R. 12 W.; Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on April 20, 1995. Found stone and crockery as called for in 1875 survey by Ed Strong, County Surveyor and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Placed a 20" Harrison monument and monument box after road reconstruction was completed. Stone may have been removed.

Bound is 2' North of CL "N" Avenue as relocated
