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I, Gary D. Hahn , in a field survey on July 7 , 19 99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- 1830 Corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor, Geo. W. Harrison "Set quarter post" R.Oak 12 S 15 ° E 8L. R. Oak 17 N 17 ° E 6L

1871 - F. Hodgeman: "Found stone planted by M.M. Stinson. Put brick around it and marked Wh. Oak 6 S 65 E 52 Whitewood 10 N 60 3/4 W 56"

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original monument and accessories not recovered. Found a ½" rod (15" long) in southbound lane of asphalt road. Rod is 0.30 feet north of bisection of line between the ratified northeast comer of section 11 and a found iron at the southeast comer of section 11. Excavated a 15' (east and west) x 12' (north and south) x 6' deep hole. Found numerous large stones and boulders below and around iron. Estimated there were ten 15" +/- round to oblong stones and two 30" - 40" boulders. No brick, drill holes, high points, chiseled X's found. Roadway does not appear to have been cut.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K4, East Quarter Post Section 11, Town 2 South, Range 12 West. Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on August 19, 1999. The position of the found ½" rod is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Replaced the ½" rod with a 20" Harrison monument in a monument box.
