B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a ½" x ½" diameter 10" long square bar in centerline of 36th Street and inside a 2" diameter 3" long pipe. Removed bar. Found a ½" diameter 18" long rod 2.4 feet below road surface slightly bent to the South. Removed. Excavated a 4' x 5' x 6' deep hole through mostly sandy soil. Found no stone. Rod was 0.06 feet North and 0.14 feet West of bar.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

A12, West Quarter Post of Section 31, Town 3 South, Range 9 West. Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on September 23, 1999. The position of the found bar is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original comer. Set a 20" Harrison Monument in a monument box in place of bar.
