

"FOUND CORNER STONE 6"x6"x24" OF RESURVEY, PUT A 1' EARTHEN POST UNDERNEATH AND REPLACED STONE WITH THE TOP EVEN WITH THE SURFACE".

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

FOUND CLAY TILE WITH "X" ON TOP APPROXIMATELY 2 FEET BELOW GRAVEL ROAD SURFACE. PLACE A CAST TILE SLEEVE OVER TILE AND INSTALLED A MONUMENT BOX.
