1888 - F. Hodgeman: "Found stake and stone and Red Oak bearing tree S 7 ° E 49 lks. in place. Set post Hickory 10" N 21 ½ ° E 92½ lks."

1993 - Robert Carr: L.C.R.C. L. 1 P. 990 Set ½" iron stake using single proportionate measurements along west line of section (section 3).

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original monument and accessories not recovered. Found ½" capped iron set by Carr 4' ± southwesterly of a 4" diameter metal fence post. The metal fence post has rusted away from its concrete base and is being held erect by two metal braces running west and north from the fence post. Excavated an extensive area around and under the fence post and the Carr iron. Removed the concrete fence post base in search of the post (tile) set in 1888 by F. Hodgeman. Found no evidence of the tile. Believe tile was removed during installation of the fence post.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

G2, East Quarter Post of Section 4, Town 3 South, Range 10 West. Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on December 16, 1999. The position of the 4" diameter metal fence post is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Set a 30" Harrison Monument directly beneath said fence post.
