1921: Wilkins & Wheaton Engineering Company; Found stone.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 - 1994: At the surface of the Road, found 1/2" iron in monument box. Dug to a depth of $5\frac{1}{2}$ '±. Found wire bent rectangularly and fragments of wood at the $3-3\frac{1}{2}$ ' depth. Found large stone with 1" iron pipe below,2.65' North and 1.0' West of iron in monument box. The stone was down 4.3' below the surface and the iron pipe down about 4.7'. One-half inch iron in monument box is believed to be the one mentioned in 1972, LCRC (Liber 1, Page 2 by Dennis Middleton.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
 - D-9 South 1/4 Post Section 20, T. 3 S., R. 12 W., Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on September 15, 1994. Found large stone with iron pipe beneatl assumed to be stone set by Hatch, as noted in 1871 resurvey by F. Hodgeman, and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Placed a 30" Harrison monument and monument box over stone.
